GENDER PAY GAP REPORT 2021**

The Charity is committed to equality in the treatment of its staff. Pay rates are regularly monitored and the charity is therefore confident that men and women are paid equally for doing similar jobs across the organisation.

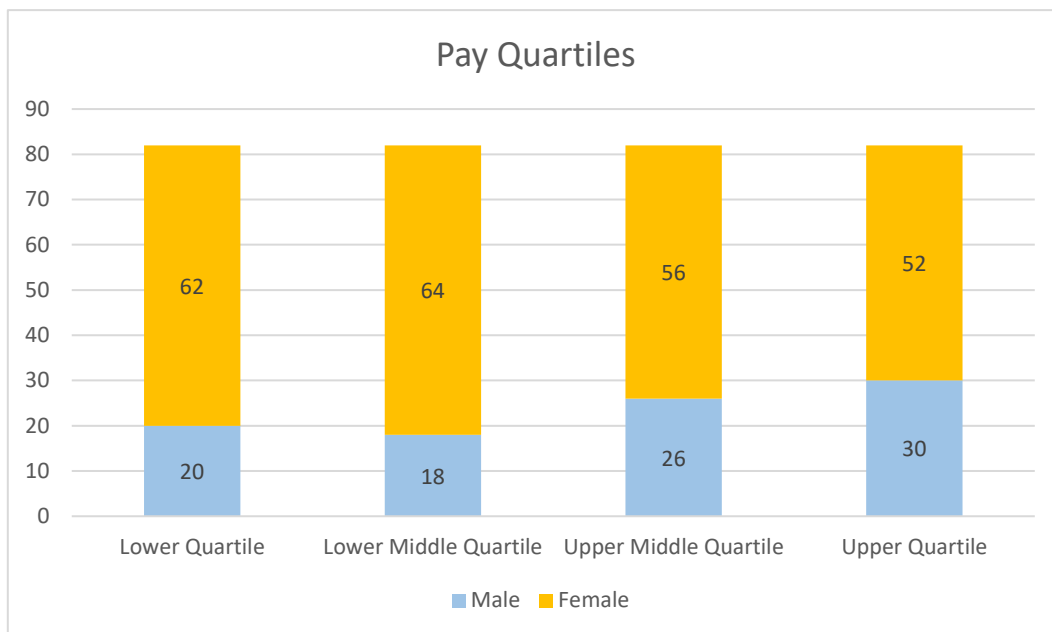
The Charity does not regularly make bonus payments. 2 bonus payments were made in the year and all were to male employees and therefore no gap calculation can be made.

Therefore, the table below shows only the overall mean and median gender pay gap based on hourly rates of pay as at April 2021.

Pay Gap	Difference between men and women	
	Mean	Median
Hourly fixed pay	12.7%	20.0%

The gender pay gap has increased in the year by 1.7% for the mean difference between men and women and 5.4% for the median. The increase in the gap over the previous year is due to changes in the mix of men and women, particularly in the lower middle quartile which has 8 fewer men and 9 more women than last year.

The chart below illustrates the gender pay distribution across the Charity, with each quartile containing 82 employees.
